Rules

The series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility

The series is open to all dinghy classes. Boats must comply with their individual class rules.

Series Sailing Instructions and Courses

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration or from the Club website (www.tbbc.org.nz). Courses will be laid in the Porirua Harbour and displayed on the whiteboard in the clubrooms.

Starts and Scoring Systems

All classes with 5 entrants on the day will be given their own start and will be scored in their class series. All other boats will start in either the long or short Open Handicap fleet. Finish times will be recorded for all boats and results will be calculated based on a combination of yardstick (using the Horowhenua list) and personal handicap. Personal handicaps will be recalculated after each day's sailing and be applied to the following day's racing.

The low point scoring system of Appendix A, rule A4 as changed below, will apply.

Six races are required to be completed to constitute either of the group 1 or group 2 series. When 6 or 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

The first sentence of rule A4.2 is changed to read "A boat that did not start shall be scored points for the finishing place 6 more than the number of boats which came to the starting area. A boat that did not finish, retired or was disqualified, will be scored one more point than the number of starters in the race."

Prizegiving

Prizegiving will take place at the completion of scoring at the end of racing on Sunday 28th August. If sailing is cancelled on this day then the prize giving will take place at 9:00am.
